General Secretary Report:

- If matches are postponed/cancelled club secretaries must inform opposing team club secretaries. Too many times already this season, club secretaries have not been informed of postponements.
- Plymouth City Council putting pitches out of bounds. League to ask Council to email Brian every week if pitches are put out. Estuary Way is also a Council pitch.
- Clubs are to be reminded of the 28 day transfer rule. A few instances of Clubs getting irritated when other Clubs refuse to waive the 28 day rule in terms of getting additional transfers from the said Club. The rules clearly state that Clubs unless a waiver is agreed cannot approach a Club again for 28 days.
- One allegation of racial abuse has been sent to Devon FA to deal with.

- Away teams visiting private pitches must seek permission from the home team for use of photographic and video equipment. On Council pitches this is not required BUT in courtesy should be asked for.
- General Secretary confirmed that Devon FA were investigating incidents relating to the Under 12 Game played between AC Plymouth and YMCA All Saints and he would inform the League of the outcome when Devon FA had concluded their investigations.
- General Secretary will not be available from Friday 17th – Monday 20th November and from Saturday 25th Nov – Tuesday 28th November. Any **urgent** issues during those times Brian Rimes will be covering. Mark will pick up and deal with emails on return.
- League chair and general secretary have meetings with both Devon and Cornwall FAs to discuss illegal approaches and action taken. Currently we have 23 ongoing cases of alleged illegal approach.
- It has been confirmed that Tothill pitch is too small for the girls' teams. Their matches will be moved to Collins Park in the interim giving the council time to resize and remark the pitch.
- Thanks passed to Bernard and Chris for arranging tonight's guests – 200 first aid kits have been issued. The company have very kindly extended the offer until 30th November 2017 for any teams who have not already claimed their free first aid kit.
- Social media – again – remind managers and parents that mini-soccer and u11 results must not be posted on social media sites.' DJM friendlies and Discussion group' on Facebook is not an official DJM site. We will be contacting the admin of the site to request if they would put a rider to that extent on the page. The League is not responsible for any incorrect information given on that page.
- Respect issues from managers/coaches ongoing. We are trying to deal with cases quickly but are tied by FA processes. We have meetings arranged with Devon and Cornwall FAs to see what we can realistically do in-house. We are determined, as a League, to tackle this issue and some action has already been taken.

8. Fixture Secretary's Report

- 8.1 I have done all the fixtures right up until the 16th December now and all are on Full-time. After the Christmas break, fixtures will start on Saturday 6th January.
- 8.2 I am starting on January's fixtures now but have to wait until after the 16th December for the under 11's fixtures as there will be some changes to the divisions. I have already started to look at the results for the under 11's and seeing which teams will potentially need to move divisions. It can prove to be a little difficult when some teams have only played one or two games not just due to the weather but with other teams postponing games.
- 8.3 Weather permitting, we hope all the fixtures will get played. Apart from the 21st Oct we haven't really lost too many yet this season.
- 8.4 I will also be looking to put in all the cup games that didn't get played on the 21st October near to the end of January thus giving us more time to sort out the next round.
- 8.5 Please reply to SMS texts from Full time. If you are not receiving them would you please contact me so I can get this checked and sorted? If match is postponed you need to reply p-p. Additionally if a referee puts the pitch out please let Anita know.
- 8.6 Plymouth Trophyman u15 Defiance charged with fielding ineligible players in cup match on 30th September 2017.

9. Mini Soccer & Girls' Registration Secretary's Report

- 9.1 Several team sheet submissions missing opponent player of the match. Lewis compiling a list of those missing to chase.

10. Girls Fixture Secretary Report

- 10.1 Bideford u18 Girls second non fulfilment of fixture on 14th October. Team to be charged and fined Rule 10(E). Also, three points deduction (10(E)(b)2).

- 10.2 Concerns raised re size of Tothill 7v7 pitch. League officer visited and checked size. It has been confirmed that Tothill pitch is too small for the girls' teams. Their matches will be moved to Collins Park in the interim giving the council time to resize and remark the pitch.
- 10.3 Ocean division u11s - Due to lack of remaining fixtures all games on December 16th have been cancelled.
- 10.4 General Secretary will be sending out email regarding the retreat rule at u11 girls.
- 10.5 If match is postponed you need to reply p-p to Full Time and let Barry know. Additionally, if a referee puts the pitch out please let Barry know.

11. Mini Soccer Co-ordinator's Report (Under 9s & 10s)

- 11.1 Fixtures have been completed until the end of the month when there will be a break for mini soccer until the beginning of February. During that time the divisions will be looked at and altered accordingly.
- 11.2 Shane reminded the Executive Committee that if mini soccer teams did not fulfil their fixture that they were to be treated the same way as competitive teams in terms of League rules that included fines being issued for short notice cancellations. Rule 10(E) applies.

12. Referee Appointments Secretary's Report

- 12.1 November fixtures have been sent out and all officials have confirmed their availability or unavailability to accept the fixtures given. At present an average of 18 referees unavailable each week. There are 55 different venues in use by teams across the League.
- 12.2 October was a better month than September with less unavailability by officials.
- 12.3 November looks like a better month for games being covered. This Saturday coming at present only 8 matches not covered. Yet the following two weeks at present 19 games do not have officials appointed.
- 12.4 I believe the system of inputting officials on Full Time on Friday night continues to go well; at least it is accurate at the time of going to press to the clubs.
- 12.5 The invoices for October have been given to the Council and Brickfields. David Lloyd, who has been my contact at Brickfields for a number of years, has now left the post and the individual doing the invoices is now in taken over his role.
- 12.6 I now have December fixtures which I have started to work on. An e-mail will be sent to officials in the coming days with regard to availability for the coming month.
- 12.7 Another official has been picked up with limited time to do fixtures, but will cover whenever available. He has been allocated a fixture at The Mill this week.
- 12.8 Having checked the system there are 27 marks where a referee has been scored 60 or less. Ian has only received 4 low mark reports so we need to check back if some of the marks have been input incorrectly. Referee mark is out of 100, maybe some teams have marked out of 10?
- 12.9 Do clubs want us to run a referees course for club members which we could arrange through Devon FA if there was sufficient interest. Feedback interest to Dave Keast please.

13. Referees Support Officer Report

Since the beginning of the season, four low mark forms have been received - 1 in September and 3 in October.

Two of the reports have been sent to the RDO for recording and monitoring; one I have spoken to the referee about and the remaining one I have spoken to the referee appointments officer about as it was felt that neither report needed any further action. One of the referees is no longer officiating.
